



Shuttle Service and Traveling with Children

At the Dana on Mission Bay, ensuring your safety remains our top concern. When transporting children (including infants), they may not sit or ride in the lap of another passenger. Each passenger must have their own seat.

Per California Vehicle Code VEH § 27363:

- Children under 2 years of age shall ride rear-facing unless the child weighs 40 or more pounds or is 40 or more inches tall.
- Children under the age of 8 must be secured in a car seat or booster seat in a back seat
- Children who are 8 years of age or have reached 4'9" in height may be secured by a booster seat, but at a minimum must be secured by a safety belt
- Passengers who are 16 years of age and older shall be properly restrained by a safety belt.
